

Camping and Camper regulations

Next to the General Terms and Conditions of the Event, the camping and camper regulations are applicable for camping visitors.

Alcohol:

You may bring a total of 4,5L of liquid, among which a maximum of 1L can be pre-mixed alcohol in original and sealed packaging*.

For example, you could either bring 4,5L of soft drinks*, or you could bring 3,5L of soft drinks and 1L of pre-mixed alcohol

- All liquid must be sealed and packed in its original packaging
- Glass packaging is not allowed
- Pre-mixed = For example, Bacardi Cola, Gin Tonic, in original and sealed packaging
- Soft drinks = soda's, beer, wine (under 15% alcohol)
- Strong liquor (alcohol percentage over 15%) is not allowed

Other Fluids:

You're allowed to bring 1 deodorant spray or perfume per person with you, but not if it's in glass packaging. Flammable fluids aren't allowed at the campsite.

Food:

You're allowed to bring your own food with you, but note that on the campsite you can find a complete food truck plaza, a 24/7 store, and mobile points selling coffee, English breakfast and fresh croissants right next to your tents. A lot of deliciousness awaits us!

Cooking on the campsite:

Cooking, open fires, camping stoves and BBQs are not allowed. We'll make sure that there are enough food trucks available to fit any appetite.

Sound:

Sound installations are not allowed.

Gas:

Gas tanks / cylinders are not allowed, also in fixed installations. Open fires, camping stoves, cooking and BBQs are also not allowed.

You are not allowed to bring any kind of drugs or weapons and nitrous oxide.

You are not allowed to wear provocative clothing like sport related shirts.

You are only allowed to travel between the campsite and the festival. Ins & outs are not allowed.

Extra Camper regulations:

- Only campers that meet the requirements laid down in the Dutch Road Traffic Regulations are allowed.
- There are no sleeping tents allowed next to your camper. You are only allowed to sleep in your camper.
- Regular campers and campervans are allowed! Folding trailers, caravans and buses are not allowed.
- Engines need to be shut off at all times.
- A maximum of 6 persons is allowed per camper.

- You need a Camper voucher (one per camper) in combination with a Camping + Weekend Ticket (for each person) to get access to the Mysteryland campsite
- The max side of a camper: length 8m and with 2,5m.
- You can only enter the Camper Paradise Grounds on Friday, August 23rd (11h-20h). Because of possible traffic jams, we advise you to come between 16h-20h.
- Exit only allowed on Monday, August 26th between 9h and 12h.
